## QUESTIONS & ANSWERS RFQ 17-00100 walk through 07/18/17 @ 1:30 PM

- 1. Is there a minimum/maximum size for the couch? and is there a preference on the fabric?
  - the minimum "lay-down length" is 5'9";
  - leather, or similar is preferred, but fabric would be considered;
  - price must fall under the price ceilings for Level A §420.20.10 Cost Ceiling for Furniture and Furnishings.
- 2. Are you looking for metal or laminate surfaces for the lateral files/book shelves/storage units?
  - wood or wood veneer preferred executive office level surfaces and materials requested;
  - price must fall under the price ceilings for Level A §420.20.10 Cost Ceiling for Furniture and Furnishings.
- 3. Regarding the hanging/floating shelf, do you mean two shelves or two openings high? and what qualifies as a mini opening?
  - overhead cabinet can be wall mounted or sit on bottom unit;
  - two shelves minimum;
  - a mini opening is considered smaller than the full size opening;
  - cabinet doors are requested, either on both ends or covering the entire upper shelves/openings of the two shelf unit.
- 4. As shown, you have requested task lighting under the hanging cabinet, where will the lighting draw its power source?
  - there is an outlet in the center and the base of the wall that the cabinets are to be hung from;
  - the cord can run down the wall on either side or be hidden by the bookcases.
- 5. Are you requesting anything in-between the upper shelf unit and the credenza/desk shell/work surface?
  - yes a tack board for the area below the cabinet unit and above the desk shell.
- 6. Do you need any of the cabinets to lock?
  - no.
- 7. Are there any surface or base requirements for the conference table?
  - executive office level surfaces and materials;
  - the table must seat six (6);
  - price must fall under the price ceilings for Level A §420.20.10 Cost Ceiling for Furniture and Furnishings.
- 8. Does the conference table need power/data?
  - no.
- 9. Are there any requirements for the chairs?
  - the chairs should have arms;
  - they are to be used as conference meeting chairs as well as casual conversation chairs;
  - materials should be metal, wood and/or fabric, no plastic;
  - wheels/castors on the conference chairs are okay;
  - price must fall under the price ceilings for Level A §420.20.10 Cost Ceiling for Furniture and Furnishings.
- 10. Can the two casual conversation chairs be a different style than the six conference chairs?
  - yes;
  - for example, a high-back executive swivel-tilt chairs could be an option for the two casual conversation chairs.
- 11. Will there be any art hung into the space?
  - yes (see attached photos);
  - large one of the faces will hang over the couch;
  - either of the smaller ones will hang on the wall opposite the window (yet to be decided).
- 12. Do you have a preference if the furniture is American made, or made from sustainable materials?
  - it is not required, but it is a good information for consideration.

- 13. Are you requiring GSA pricing?
  - no it is open market;
  - the cost ceilings for this project are at Level A §420.20.10 Cost Ceiling for Furniture and Furnishings, list attached.
- 14. Will you be awarding the entire quote or piecing out the award?
  - the preference is to keep the quote/award together to keep delivery and installation costs down;
  - single items could be considered because it is open market pricing.
- 15. Do you need monitor arm or a task chair?
  - no please only quote the items on the list.
- 16. Where will the power for the desk come from?
  - the wall outlet in the middle of the wall, under the window.
- 17. Can you supply us with a CAD file?
  - yes please give me 24 hours to get one from our IT department.
- 18. What is your timing do you have a schedule or deadline?
  - I have to have orders placed by the end of this fiscal year, September 29, 2017;
  - our goal is to place the order in the first two weeks of August;
  - we will be juggling the furniture around the remodel;
  - installation of the upper cabinets will have to TBA after the GSA remodel.
- 19. Do you need the office ADA accessible?
  - yes.
- 20. Would you like delivery costs on a separate line in the quote?
  - ves.
- 21. Would you like a quote for installation of the hanging/floating cabinet?
  - yes; \*note that GSA will be reinforcing the wall for support to hang any cabinet;
  - installation timing would be after the completion of the wall fabric installation;
  - \*also note, that you can quote an upper cabinet unit that sits on the lower unit that only needs to be mounted to the wall.
- 22. Is there anything you can tell us that would help us decide or think about the design aesthetic?
  - judicial executive;
  - lived-in;
  - organic flow to the design;
  - collection of pieces over the years (not-matchy matchy);
  - a pop of red or dark blue to bring in the building into the design;
  - timeless.
