

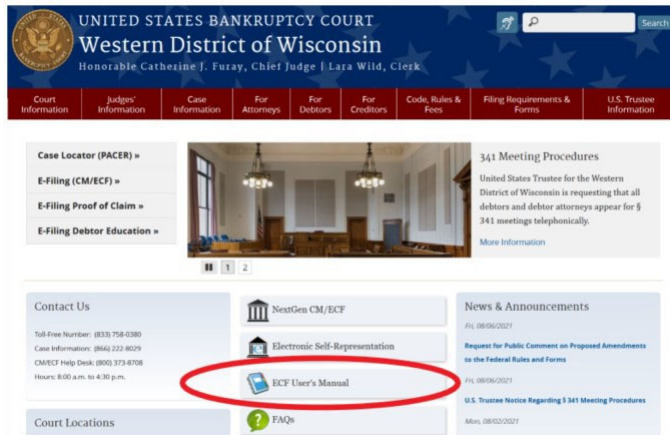
# Submit Orders to the Court in the Correct Format
