## Notice of Proposed Revised Local Rules and Opportunity for Public Comment

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Wisconsin hereby gives notice of proposed permanent changes in its Local Rules, and invites comment thereon. The new Rules will go into effect on December 1, 2015.

## Summary of proposed changes:

Rule 1007-1-2: The Court is updating the Official Form number from Schedule D to Schedule B106D or B206D (Schedule D: Creditors Who Have Claims Secured by Property) to conform with the amendments to the Bankruptcy Forms.

Rule 1019-1: The Court is updating the Official Form number from B1 (Voluntary Petition) to conform with the amendments to the Bankruptcy Forms.

The new forms will be: B101 Voluntary Petition for Individuals Filing for Bankruptcy; B101A Initial Statement About an Eviction Judgment Against You; B101B Statement About Payment of an Eviction Judgment Against You; and B201 Voluntary Petition for Non-Individuals Filing for Bankruptcy.

This will also include the following as appropriate: Exhibit A, Form B201A Attachment to Voluntary Petition for Non-Individuals Filing for Bankruptcy Under Chapter 11; Exhibit C Forms B101 and B201 Hazardous Property or Property That Needs Immediate Attention -- incorporated in Forms B101 and B201; and Exhibit D Form B101 Individual Debtor's Statement of Compliance with Credit Counseling Requirement – Incorporated in Form B101.
