FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

A hearing on the application of the Creditors' Committee for appointment of attorneys nunc pro tunc and for allowance of attorneys' fees and expenses having been held on the 20th day of August, 1981; the Creditors' Committee appearing by Bradley A. Kennedy, one of its attorneys; and Roland J. Kennedy, secretary of the Creditors' Committee, and Edward F. Zappen, disbursing agent, also appearing; and the Court having heard the arguments of counsel and a statement as to the relative position of the parties, and being fully advised in the premises, FINDS:

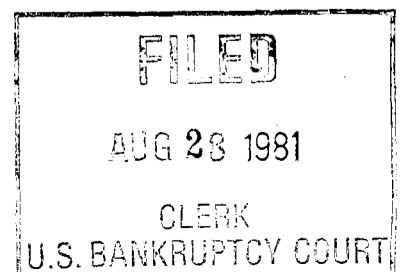
1. That the material allegations of the application are proven and true.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That an order should be entered approving the nunc pro tunc appointment of the law firm of Krueger, Thums, Trusty & Hittner, S. C., and allowing the attorneys' fees and expenses as claimed in the sum of \$1,630.50.

2. That the claim of Roland J. Kennedy as secretary of the Creditors' Committee for expenses of travel and telephone in the sum of \$163.36 should be allowed.

3. That Charles F. Schroeder, attorney of record for Dickman Homes, Inc., should be allowed his fees and expenses as claimed for services rendered in October 1979.



O R D E R

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That the law firm of Krueger, Thums, Tlusty & Hittner, S. C. is appointed nunc pro tunc as attorneys for the Creditors' Committee and allowed attorneys' fees and expenses in the sum of \$1,630.50.

2. That the claim of Roland J. Kennedy as secretary of the Creditors' Committee is allowed in the sum of \$163.36.

3. That Charles F. Schroeder, attorney of record for Dickman Homes, Inc., is hereby allowed his fees and expenses as claimed for services rendered in October 1979.
