FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

The plaintiff in the above entitled action having duly filed by written complaint an objection to the dischargeability of the debt due it from the defendant-debtor; and the defendant having duly filed his answer to the complaint; and a pre-trial having been held; and the matter having been noticed for trial and a trial having been held; and witnesses having been duly sworn and testimony taken; and the attorneys having filed written memorandums; and the Court being fully advised in the premises, FINDS:

- 1. That the defendant-debtor filed a petition for relief herein on October 22, 1979.
- 2. That the plaintiff duly filed his complaint as above stated.
- 3. That the defendant has satisfactorily explained the omission of the exempt pension funds from his schedules.
- 4. That it appears from the evidence that a felonious assault occurred on December 15, 1979, resulting in the loss of the monies involved.
- 5. That said pension funds were exempt under the Wisconsin Statutes.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That an order be entered dismissing the plaintiff's complaint herein without costs to either party.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: That the plaintiff's complaint in the above entitled action be and the same is hereby dismissed upon the merits and without costs to either of the parties.
