ORDER MODIFYING STAY


The application of Cary M. Brooks, Donald D. Gay, Olaf E. Larson and Earl R. Larson to modify the stay afforded by 11 U.S.C. 362 so as to permit them to continue a suit heretofore commenced against various debtors named in the moving papers having been heard on the 19th day of June, 1980; and due service having been made upon the debtor; and after hearing the evidence and argument of counsel, and the examination of the record and the moving papers, and the attorneys having filed written briefs, the Court is of the opinion that the continuation of said suit will not hinder, burden, delay or be inconsistent with these proceedings, and that a stay of the continuation of said suit would work an injustice, and that the continuation of said suit is necessary for the working out of any Plan in this proceedings;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: That Cary M. Brooks, Donald D. Gay, Olaf E. Larson and Earl R. Larson be and they are hereby authorized to continue the suit now pending in state court entitled Brooks, et al -vs- Selenske, et al., Marquette County, Case No. 79-CV-144; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the stay afforded by 11 U.S.C. 362 be and it is hereby modified to that extent.
