The above named debtors having filed a motion to convert the above proceedings from a Chapter 11 to a Chapter 13, and the same having been duly noticed for hearing; and the debtors having appeared in person and by Gary L. Dreier, their attorney; and E. John Buzza having appeared for Wolohan Lumber Company and the American Savings and Loan Association of Stevens Point; and Robert F. Konkol having appeared for the Citizens National Bank of Stevens Point; and the Court having heard the testimony of the witness sworn in said proceedings, and having heard the arguments of counsel, and having duly considered the entire record, and being fully advised in the premises, FINDS:

1. That said debtors filed a petition for a Chapter 11 proceedings on the 19th day of September, 1980, and that the first meeting of creditors was held on October 21, 1980.
2. That said debtors have been unable to work out a satisfactory plan pursuant to the provisions of reorganization.
3. That on May 27, 1981, the debtors filed a request for conversion from Chapter 11 to Chapter 13 together with a petition and plan, and on June 6, 1981, they filed a motion for conversion and a hearing thereon was duly held as above stated.
4. That the debtors have not been discharged under Section 1141(d) of the Bankruptcy Code, and that said debtors have requested such conversion.

5. That the motion to convert said proceedings from a Chapter 11 to a Chapter 13 is granted.

6. That said Chapter 13 proceed as provided in the Bankruptcy Code with a first meeting of creditors and a hearing on application for approval and confirmation of the plan.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


That an order be entered granting the motion for conversion from Chapter 11 to Chapter 13.
