ORDER GRANTING MOTION

That an order be entered granting said motion and directing the trustee to proceed for the determination and collection of said preference.

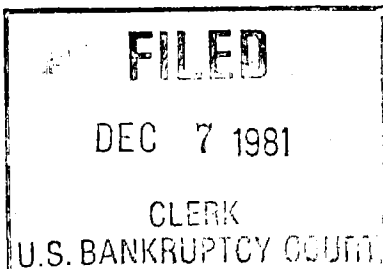
O R D E R


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:
