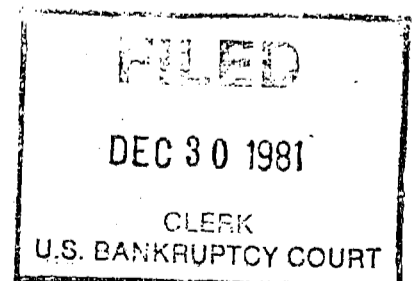
1. That the material allegations of plaintiffs' moving papers and the record and file do not warrant or support an order disqualifying said attorneys herein.

O R D E R


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:
