FINDINGS OF FACT
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW and ORDER

The debtor having filed an application to reject an executory contract with the United States of America, Robins Air Force Base, and the same having been noticed for hearing; the debtor appearing by its officers and attorneys; Chad H. Gettleman appearing on behalf of the Creditors Committee, and John A. Byrnes, United States Attorney, appearing on behalf of the United States of America; and the Court having heard the arguments of counsel, and having taken the matter under advisement and being fully advised in the premises,
FINDS:

1. That from the testimony offered by the debtor, the Robins Air Force Base advised debtor by letter of its desire to terminate said contract, and that it is to the best interest of debtor's estate that the application be granted.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

That an order be entered rejecting the executory contract with the United States of America, Robins Air Force Base.


O R D E R
