ORDER DETERMINING ATTORNEY FEES AND DISBURSEMENTS

The Court having entered an order dismissing the plaintiff's complaint in the above entitled matter on the 20th day of October, 1983, and having directed that the defendants submit a proposed claim of costs and attorney fees, and that the Court would thereafter determine the amount allowable under Section 523, subsection (d); and the defendants' attorney having

submitted a petition and claim for fees and disbursements in the sum of \$790.90; and the plaintiff having objected to the allowance of said sum and contended that the fees are payable under arrangements with Judicare; and the Court having considered the application and the objection. FINDS:

- 1. That the expenses in the sum of \$55.95 are reasonable and proper.
- 2. That the amount of attorney fees allowable under the statute is the sum of \$350.00.
- 3. That the contention that Judicare is wholly responsible is not tenable.
- 4. That the defendants' attorney is not to collect double but may collect the difference from the amount allowed herein so as to have his bill paid in full.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

That an order be entered allowing the costs in the sum of \$55.95 and attorney fees in the sum of \$350.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the attorney fee allowable under Section 523(d) is \$350.00 plus the costs in the

sum of \$55.95.
