


MEMORANDUM OPINION,  
FINDINGS OF FACT, AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The First National Bank of Ironwood (FNBI) was issued an Order to Show Cause why proceeds from a land contract were applied contrary to the manner prescribed in the debtors' confirmed plan of reorganization. FNBI appears by David E. McDonald, Jr. The debtors appear by John J. Sattler. Craig Olson appears by Dennis M. Burgy, and Hub City Foods appears by Walter G. Wefel, Jr. A hearing was held on this matter on August 20, 1986. The parties were provided opportunity to submit briefs and such briefs have been filed. The court has received the briefs and has considered the arguments made and the authorities cited therein. It is the conclusion of the court that this matter should be set for an evidentiary hearing.
