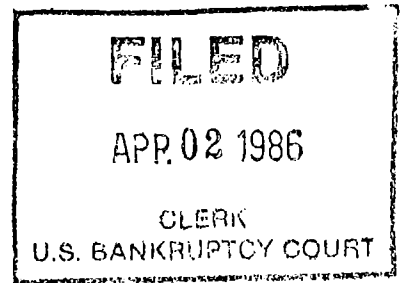

OPINION AND ORDER

The debtors appear pro se and motion the court for relief from the claim of First Wisconsin National Bank of Eau Claire. Oral arguments were allowed at a hearing on February 14, 1986. 
This opinion shall constitute findings of fact and conclusions of law in accordance with Bankruptcy Rule 7052.
