OPINION AND ORDER

The debtors proceed pro se and bring two motions before this court. The debtors' first motion requests this court to grant a rehearing on the relief from stay motion of Royal Credit Union pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 9023 and Rule 59(a)(2) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and asks that such rehearing be a Trial by Jury pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 9015.
